The University of Manchester

建于1824年，学校位于英国第二繁华城市曼彻斯特，是世界三十强顶尖名校，英国著名的六所“红砖大学”之一，英国“常春藤联盟”罗素大学集团的创始成员之一，也是英国最大的单一校址大学。作为全球顶尖的科研与教学机构之一，共有25位诺贝尔奖得主，为全英之冠。2026年QS世界大学排名位列35位。

曼彻斯特有“英国第二城”和“知识之都”之称，备受英国本国和海外学生的青睐；作为英国的第二大经济体，金融与专业服务业在英国各地区中排名第一，创意数字化与媒体行业在全欧洲排名第二。在流行文化，尤其是音乐、时装、设计方面，曼彻斯特可与伦敦相媲美，而生活费用远低于伦敦。此外，曼彻斯特有两只著名的足球队：曼彻斯特城队与曼彻斯特联队。曼彻斯特大学坐落在世界上第一座工业化城市—英国曼彻斯特市。从曼城每天有数趟火车直达伦敦，全程仅需要2小时。公共巴士经过大学直达曼彻斯特国际机场，仅需1小时。

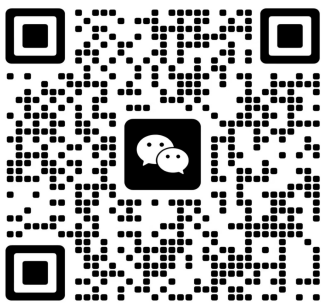
